New York State Superintendent of Insurance

Please join The American Society of Workers Comp Professionals, the Council of Insurance Brokers of Greater New York and the Insurance Brokers Association of the State of New York, Inc. on Thursday, December 13, 2007 as we welcome the Hon. Eric R. Dinallo as our keynote speaker.

Eric R. Dinallo was nominated by Governor Eliot Spitzer to be the 39th Superintendent of the New York State Insurance Department. He was confirmed on April 18, 2007 and serves as the Department's Superintendent.

Superintendent Dinallo joined the Department from Willis Group Holdings, the world's third largest insurance broker, where he was General Counsel and a member of the company's global executive management committee.

From 2003 to 2006, Mr. Dinallo was the Managing Director, Global Head of Regulatory Affairs for Morgan Stanley. He designed and led top-to-bottom reviews of conflicts and business practices and chaired the Global Conflicts Committee.

At the Office of Attorney General Eliot Spitzer from 1999 to 2003, he was Chief of the Investment Protection Bureau. He led the Bureau's investigations into the Wall Street Cases – conflicts of interest in the financial services industry, including research analyst cases and the spinning of hot initial public offerings. Under his leadership, the Bureau produced more than 40 major civil and criminal matters.

Before joining the Attorney General's office, Mr. Dinallo served as an Assistant District Attorney in the New York County District Attorney's office and as a Litigation Associate with the Manhattan law firm of Paul, Weiss, Rifkin, Wharton & Garrison.

Mr. Dinallo earned a B.A. from Vassar College, an M.A. from Duke University School of Public Policy and a law degree from New York University.
